When replacing a gas gauge float that's lost its buoyancy, I've struggled to secure the new one to the end of the gauge arm. The original crimp that keeps the little retaining washer in place is small, difficult to re-use, and sometimes rusty.



After 15 minutes of fishing for it in the tank, I groped for a simple cure. Although it adds a bit of weight, I gently forced a two-inch piece of solder into the float, along-side the already installed arm. Common, thin electrical solder offers a nice, snug fit.
