Suction created by the pumping of the pistons, causes fuel and air to flow through the carburetor into the engine.

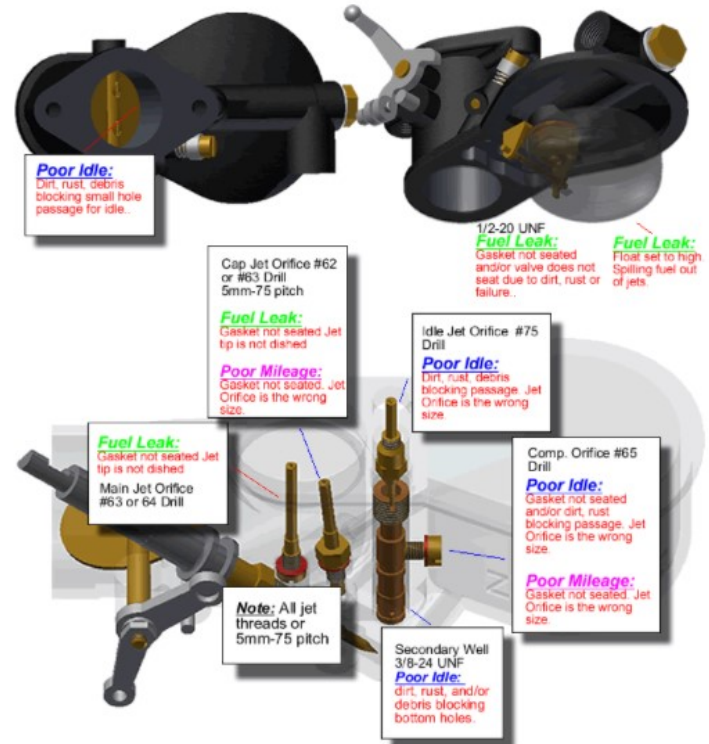
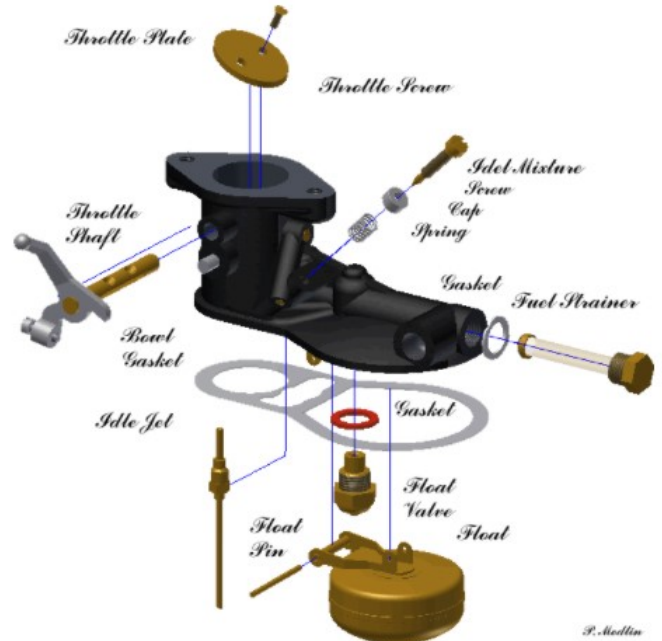
Each alternate downward stroke draws in a fresh charge of mixed fuel and air.

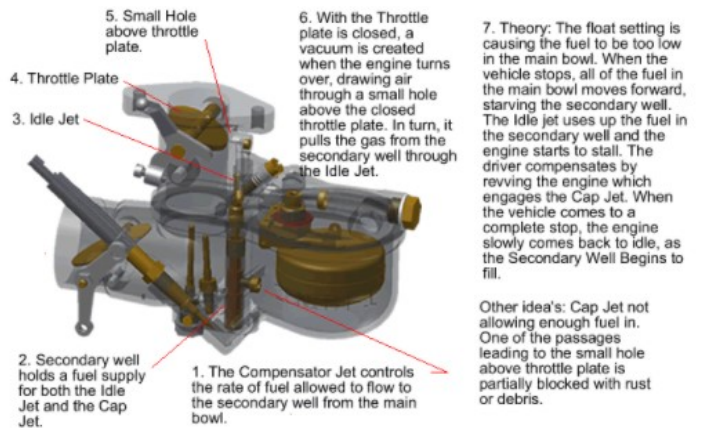

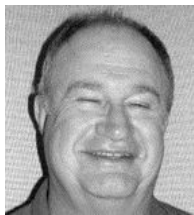

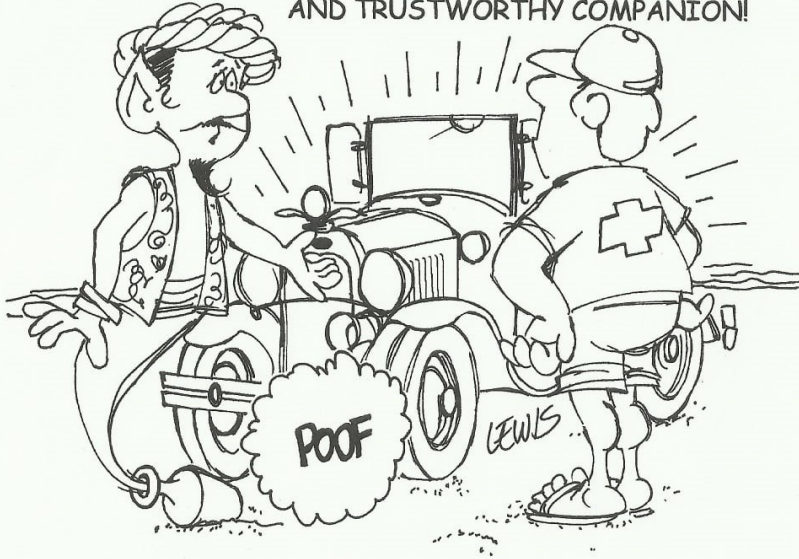
